- 7gypsies 2 ring binder 6x6 naked journal.
- A collection of fabrics. Fat quarters and scraps are perfect.
- Braids, ribbons, trims, buttons
- I've used 7gypsies measurement gaffer tape.
- DMC Cottons and threads.
- Embellishments such as paper flowers, ricrac, photocorners
- Bazzill and Making Memories cardstock and maybe some scrapbook papers.
- A template with line markings.
- Pens and markers, grey lead pencil.
- A small box of chocolates (no-one but you need know they're in there).
- Power Pritt Gel glue
- Double-sided tape.
- Scissors - for paper and fabric.
- Making Memories Acrylic paints and a paintbrush.
- Making Memories paper tag
- Some double sided iron on interfacing known as Vliesofix
- Weaveline light weight interfacing
- Some clear reinforcements.
- Your rotary cutter (I have one just for paper), mat and ruler.
- Sewing machine.
- Lightbox and fabric pen for tracing stitchery.
- Embroidery needle and a hoop.
- Making Memories velvet ribbon from their vintage hip trims range.
- Fabric daisy chain from the Making Memories vintage hip trims range.
- Swing tags from any office supply store.
- 7gypsies rub-ons to finish the look.
- Making Memories pin
